Aims & Objectives








Organization Organogram

Activities undertaken during this year

Livelihood

All the activities which are involved in solving the basic needs of human being for their survival comes under livelihood activities.

Active initiative has been taken by the organization with judicious support NABARD to reach the vulnerable communities and involve them with many livelihoods' income generating activities



In 2 number of States and 3 number districts touching 4,500 HHs; many need-based livelihood programs are made in the intervention areas like mushroom, fisheries and back yard poultry.



Governance & Institutional Development Services

In order to achieve our goal and objectives dynamic professionals are involved for better outcome of our activities.

In 5 number of States and 8 number districts touching 4,800 HHs; Institutional Development Services are undertaken.

12 dysfunctional SHGs were streamlined and made functional.
40 number Formation of Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) & 8 number of Farmer Clubs (FCs) were formed.

4 number of SHG Federation were made.



Agricultural Development Services

To end the extreme poverty; agricultural development services acts as the most powerful tool to address healthy & sustainable development.

In 5 number of states covering 8 number of districts and 4800 number of HHs agricultural development work was implemented.



System of Rice Intensification, Line transplanting of Paddy for productivity Enhancement; Machine Transplanter to tackle labor problem are some of major interventions.

Organic Farming and mushroom cultivation were major activities made this year.

Scientific Fisheries and Bio-floc are promoted providing training and linking the farmers with the line departments.



Marketing Support Services

This year the implementing team made

their efforts to joint the knots of marketing services like marketing plans with development process to make financial products and services accessible and affordable to all individuals

20 number of finished products from 15 FPOs were made accessible in affordable price in 5 number of states.





Financial Inclusion Services


9 FPOs and 5 SHGs were linked with banks to fulfill the credit requirement of these institutions. Besides, NBFCs were introduced with FPOs to cater the short-term credit requirement.



Natural Resource Management (including organic practices and renewable energy)

Realizing the fact that without natural resource, the existence of human being will be difficult. If proper management of natural resources will not be addressed neither we can breathe clean air nor we will get clean water and plants to eat and drink.

Initiative was taken by the organization for proper management of land, water soil, plants and animals for better quality of life. This year in 3 number blocks covering 450 HHs were covered under organic practices. Progressive work was also made on renewable energy like solar energy.



Preventive health & nutrition (including WASH)

This year, active initiative was taken to address better nutrition, water sanitation and hygiene in our implementing areas through WASH program.

In 2 number of States in 3 number of Districts covering 12 number of Blocks and 3,000 number of HHs under WASH program was commenced to address the health aspects. Low-cost toilets were introduced and people were sensitized to use toilets.



Women, Rights & Entitlement

In order to free women from domestic violence, YK-LIBRA since its inception has promoted SHGs and facilitated various training, business plan development to women SHGs on vegetable cultivation, goat rearing and poultry etc. Through various need-based program focus has been made to empower women and turn them as successful entrepreneurs in various sustainable livelihood income generating activities so that they can be empowered.



Disaster Management and Climate change

This initiative is to provide opportunities for the local community to evaluate their own situation based on their own experiences initially. During the planning process, the local communities became part of creating plans and decisions and also prepared how to come into action during disaster time.

Organization has also addressed climate change effect through various need-based program. Apart from that, Organization tries to rehabilitate the degraded land to increase the crop intensity.



Action Research & Studies

Action Research and Studies are conducted to make necessary customization of the methodology as per the requirement of the local situation.

Action research is conducted in back yard poultry to develop local specific package of practices. Similarly, a number of interventions are incorporated while development of package of practices for SRI, Mushroom Production, Organic Farming etc.



Social Awareness



Steps taken to bridge the information gap about the rights and entitlement that is there for the people. Needbased sensitization meetings in village level were also duly made.


National Environment Awareness Campaign under Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India was the highlighted activity made this year in Odisha covering 500 People.


