
YK-LIBRA: Growing with Confidence


- Women empowerment through organizing, mobilizing, developing capacity and skills and creating provision of inclusion in decision making process in family and community enabling them to become economically and socially independent.



Activities undertaken during this year

Responsible Livelihood

In 3 number of States and 4 number districts touching 6,000 HHs; many need based livelihood program were made in the intervention areas like mushroom, fisheries and back yard poultry.

Training on Composite Fish Farming, Fingerling production through local Entrepreneurs, Market linkage for feed, seed, medicine, training on Scientific approach to Back Yard Poultry, Supply of Chicks, feed, medicine, Vaccination program through Local Resource Person, Marketing support for sales of eggs and birds were some highlighted work activities made.



Governance & Institutional Development Services

This year initiative has been taken by the organization to strengthen the capacity of group and make them organizationally and financially sustainable and empower them because they have the potential to raise awareness about issues affecting women and children and inculcate the habit of saving towards positive development in the community.



In 6 number of States and 12 number districts touching 7,000 HHs; Institutional Development services were undertaken.

- I. 12 number of Self-Help Groups (SHGs) were formed
- II. 61 number Formation of Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs)
- III. 10 number of Farmers Club (FC) were formed
- IV. 4 number of SHG Federation were made



Agricultural Development Services

In 6 number of states covering 12 number of districts and 7,000 number of HHs in agricultural development work was made.

System of Rice Intensification: Line transplanting of Paddy for productivity Enhancement, Machine Transplanter to tackle labor problem.

Organic Farming and mushroom cultivation were major activities made this year.

Scientific Fisheries and Bio-floc are promoted providing training and linking the farmers with the line departments.





Marketing Support Services

The implementing team made all their efforts to make financial products and services accessible and affordable to all individuals

30 number of finished products from 23 FPOs were made accessible in affordable price in 6 number of states.



Financial Inclusion Services

11 FPOs and 7 SHGs were linked with banks to fulfull the credit requirement of these institutions. Besides, NBFCs were introduced with FPOs to cater the short-term credit requirement.



Natural Resource Management

(including organic practices and renewable energy)

Initiative was taken by the organization for proper management of land, water soil, plants and animals for better quality of life. This year in 6 number blocks covering 900 HHs were covered under organic practices. Progressive work was also made on renewable energy like solar energy.



Preventive health & nutrition (including WASH)

This year active initiative was taken to address better nutrition, water sanitation and hygiene in our implementing areas through WASH program.

In 2 number of States in 3 number of Districts covering 12 number of Blocks and 3,000 number of HHs under WASH program was commences to address the health aspects. Low-cost toilets were introduced and people were sensitized to use toilets.



Women, Rights & Entitlement

In order to free women from domestic violence, YK-LIBRA since its inception has promoted SHGs and facilitated various training, business plan development to women SHGs on vegetable cultivation, goat rearing and poultry etc. Through various need-based program focus has been made to empower women and turn them as successful entrepreneurs in various sustainable livelihood income generating activities so that they can be empowered.



Disaster Management and Climate change

This initiative is to provide opportunities for the local community to evaluate their own situation based on their own experiences initially. During the planning process, the local communities became part of creating plans and decisions and also prepared to how to come into action during disaster time.

Organization has also addressed climate change effect through various needbased program organization tries to rehabilitate the degraded land to increase the crop intensity.



Action Research & Studies

Action Research and Studies are conducted to make necessary customization of the methodology as per the requirement of the local situation.

Action research is conducted in back yard poultry to develop local specific package of practices. Similarly a number of interventions are incorporated while development of package of practices of SRI.



Social Awareness

YK-Libra with the support of district administration of various operation areas, has done social awareness program on COVID-19. Uses of mask, sanitization of hands, social distancing etc were ensure at community level.

Steps taken to bridge the information gap about the rights and entitlement that is there for the people. Need-based sensitization meetings in village level were also duly made.

Campaign on alcohol free village, Swacha Bharat Abhijan and Gender equality were some highlighted activities done this year in Odisha, West Bengal and Tripura.
